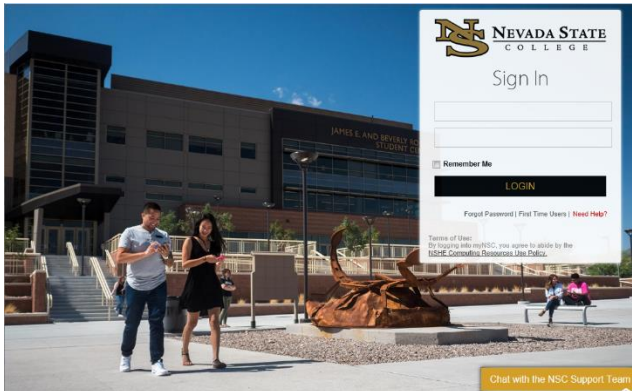


Navigating to Transfer Credit Report (TCR)

1. Login to the NSC Portal (<http://my.nsc.edu>)
 2. Click on the Student Center link
 3. Under Academics, select Transfer Credit Report from the drop-down menu
 4. Transfer Credit Report will display:
 - a. Course Credits
 - b. Test Credits
 - c. Other Credits

Step 1

Login to the [NSC Portal](http://my.nsc.edu) using your NSHE ID and password.

Step 2

Select the **Student Center** link to login to myNSC Student Center.
